Pune-based International Institute for Information Technology (I2IT) today signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Italy's International Center for Theoretical Physics (ICTP) for conducting training workshops for professionals/students from developing countries. The joint projects between I2IT and ICTP/ITU.

In the first phase, I2IT and ICTP will set up training workshops in China, Sri Lanka, Nepal, Maldives, Bangladesh, Pakistan, and other developing countries in the area of Wireless Technologies, Networking and Telecommunications.

I2IT with assistance from ICTP would organize special educational programs for students from developing countries, including graduate studies. I2IT will be a focal point for contacts to Indian industries for collaborative projects with ICTP.
